Notice is hereby given that the Hopkinton Zoning Board of Adjustment will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, March 1, 2005, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Town Hall to review and take action on the following:

TH05-1SP-3-1 David W. Jones, President of the Hopkinton State Fair – Applicant requests a Special Use Permit to hold an event known as the Annual Sheep & Wool Festival. The event is to be held on May 14 and 15, 2005 with an estimated attendance of between 2,500 and 4,000 people per day. The event will take place on property owned by the Hopkinton State Fair Association, Inc., shown on Tax Map 222 as Lots 57.2, 59, 60, 61 & 79.

TH05-2SP-3-2 David W. Jones, President of the Hopkinton State Fair – Applicant requests a Special Use Permit to hold an event known as the Amateur Radio and Computer Flea Market. The event is to be held on May 6 and 7, 2005 and October 7 and 8, 2005 with an estimated attendance of between 2,000 and 3,000 people per day. The event will take place on property owned by the Hopkinton State Fair Association, Inc., shown on Tax Map 222 as Lots 57.2, 59, 60, 61 & 79.

TH05-3SP-3-3 David W. Jones, President of the Hopkinton State Fair – Applicant requests a Special Use Permit to hold an event known as the NHMRO Annual Motorcycle Flea Market. The event is to be held on April 24, 2005 with an estimated attendance of between 1,000 and 2,000 people per day. The event will take place on property owned by the Hopkinton State Fair Association, Inc., shown on Tax Map 222 as Lots 57.2, 59, 60, 61 & 79.

TH05-4SP-3-4 David W. Jones, President of the Hopkinton State Fair – Applicant requests a Special Use Permit to hold an event known as the NH Highland Games. The event is to be held from September 23 to September 25, 2005 with an estimated attendance of 21,681 as reported in 2004. The event will take place on property owned by the Hopkinton State Fair Association, Inc., shown on Tax Map 222 as Lots 57.2, 59, 60, 61 & 79.
