Contoocook Village Precinct Monthly Meeting

March 8, 2011

There was a meeting of the Contoocook Village Precinct Commissioners on Tuesday March 8, 2011. The meeting was held at the Slusser Center and began at 7 P.M. Mark Hemmerlein, Bill Chapin, Tom Yestramski, Dick Strickford, Kathy Donohoe, and Steve Clough were present.

Kathy provided the Profit and Loss Report showing expenditures to date. The Commissioners signed checks and manifests. The Annual Precinct Meeting is Tuesday March 15, 2011 and will begin at 7 P.M. Bill will check with Lloyd to see if he is willing to be Moderator this year. Kathy left the meeting.

Dick reported on a few issues. There is 3" of water going over the dam spillway, there is no sign of Beaver, the watershed roads are all in good shape, and snowmobiles are staying on the upper trails mostly. Dick also urged the Commissioners to come up with an ordinance regarding encroachment around fire hydrants by property owners.

Steve went over a few issues. The valves have been replaced at the filtration plant, there have been several shutoff and service requests which have been taken care of, and all testing is up to date. The agreement letter from EJP has been revised as requested but there are also several other items having to do with billing software, notifications, shutoffs, and scheduling that will have to be dealt with.

Tim White, Steve Lajoie, and Charlie Head from the Hopkinton Village Precinct joined the meeting to discuss their situation as it might relate to the Contoocook Village Precinct's current system analysis. The HVP Commissioners briefed the CVP Commissioners on their current status, system deficiencies, rate base, and future options. The CVP Commissioners agreed to consider further discussions on some type of arrangement between the 2 Precincts contingent upon the findings of the CVP's Engineer. If any analysis of the HVP's current system was necessary to facilitate further discussions then they would finance them.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:30 P.M.
