Minutes of February 17, 2010 Meeting

Committee members present were Glen Ohlund, John Herrick, Judy Hampe, Bob Houston, Sue Leadbeater, Bob Gerseny and Cettie Connolly

A motion was made by Mr. Gerseny and seconded by Mrs. Hampe to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2010.

The Committee discussed development of the Bio Energy site and wondered how much revenue the business at Exit 9 provide to Warner.

Glen noted he would email the committee a boilerplate Conflict of Interest statement from the Division of Charitable Trust for the committee to review. Glen stated that persons serving on committees should sign a Conflict of Interest statement on a yearly basis.

Glen stated a letter had been sent to Dr. Rosen. Dr. Rosen informed Glen that the information requested by the committee would be forthcoming. Glen informed him that the committee needed the information in order to make a decision on supporting this project.

The committee discussed retaining a Retail Consultant to work with the business community. After discussion, it was decided that Glen would draft a letter to the individual businesses community noting that the committee was discussing a Retail Consultant and ask for their feedback.

The committee also discussed adding the businesses to the town website with possible links to businesses website. Bob Gerseny will speak with the Selectmen's Office.

Glen reported that he had met with the Selectmen and they discussed Exit 6 for possible development, and Glen requested the town notify the EDC of town properties to be auctioned off.
