The committee met at the Kimball Cabins to discuss work that needs to be done to the main cabin. Dan Nivelles had sent us the list of work that he and Derek found needing to be done on the cabins. We reviewed and agreed that the front porch needs to be replaced. Repair the trim under the porch eaves, strip and reroof. We also want to remove the cabinets, remove the wall separating the two rooms, remove the shower room and the storage area in the first room. We are in hopes of finding a mason who will come to repair the fireplace in the second room. The cabin needs to be caulked and painted this summer.

Lee has continued discussions concerning the 70' X 70' lot and will continue to update the committee.

Ed will look into the various materials that are recommended for caulking between the logs and report back at the next meeting.

Carl will draft an outline of the work that needs to be done on the cabin. He will contact Ernie Thibideau, mason, to have him look at the chimney to recommend what needs to be done to make it safe to use again.

John will develop a materials list with the cost associated.

Chris will discuss the naming of the main cabin with Jim.
