Meeting Minutes April 7, 2015

We would like to make a sign that replicates the original sign and have it say "Kimball Lake Horseshoe Trail Camps Public Recreation Area". Have written on the bottom available for use and the contact info. Have the cabins included on the recreational rental forms. Ask Paula to develop a page for the Kimball Lake & cabins to help promote the area through the recreation dept. website.

It was suggested we could have antique car shows on Sunday afternoons. In the winter months have broomball games, ice fishing, hockey, & skating in Jan. & Feb. We will ask DPW to clear an area 2 times during the winter and find others to help keep it clear. It was mentioned that Jed Merrow would be interested in helping out.

Paula will have a port-a-potty delivered to the area on May 15th and will stay throughout the summer until Oct. 15th. We will make a recommendation to Paula as to the placement of the toilet. An appointment has been made to have clivus inspected as to its overall condition. Lee will report back to the committee of how the inspection went.

A local contractor gave us an estimate of \$2,350 to assist 4 volunteers to install metal clad roofing on cabin #1. The materials will be purchased through Cyr Lumber. As soon as we can raise the funds we will start this project. Ed will stop by Cyr Lumber to pick up color samples of the metal clad roof materials and solid stain colors. The committee will meet on Sunday April 12th at the cabins to pick the colors.

Maple Street school will be using the main cabin on June 5th for the annual art & science day. Paula has scheduled the Lets Go Fishing program for June 1st & 3rd. The Hopkinton Historical hike on the greenway trail is June 13th. This event is part of the 250th celebration so we would like to take this opportunity to promote the area by having a BBQ and other foods available at the cabins, hand out our brochure and make a lexan donation box made with a horseshoe placed on the front.

Ricardo will contact the high school wood shop teacher to see if they are willing to make us picnic tables.

Lee & Carl have been working at the main cabin as time permits to finish a few items so we can get an occupancy permit by June 1st. Lee handed out the priority work list and work details were assigned.
