

Hopkinton/Webster Landfill Committee
Minutes – February 14, 2008

The meeting opened at 7:00pm in the Senior Center, Hopkinton, NH.

Present were Robert Drown Sr., Linda Hook, Gordon Welch, Louise Carr, Peter Russell, Karen Irwin, Steven Clough. Also present, Selectmen Tom Mullins, Webster and members of the Hopkinton Recycling Committee.

The first order of business was to elect a Chairman and Secretary for the Landfill Transfer Station Committee. A coin was tossed to determine which town was to chair the committee. Hopkinton won the toss. Robert Drown Sr. made a motion, and it was seconded by Linda Carr to appoint Peter Russell as chair and Gordon Welch as secretary. All approved.

It was then discussed and decided by all present that the Committee meetings will be held on the first Thursday of every month in alternating towns, starting with this meeting. The next meeting will be held in Webster on March 6, 2008.

A discussion followed pertaining to the current years expenditures for 2007. The Landfill Revenue report was distributed to all members and Mr. Russell asked if there were any questions, there were none. Mr. Clough will provide this report monthly. Mr. Clough will also provide the Committee with quarterly statements on revenue and expenses.

It was confirmed that both towns have a Capital Improvement Fund set up for the Transfer Station.

The Recycling Committee from Hopkinton asked to accelerate the July tipping fees for haulers from \$20.00 to \$30.00 per ton immediately if possible. A discussion followed and the subject was voted down at this time. A motion was made by Linda Hook to speak with the haulers and was seconded by Robert Drown. Mr. Clough will invite the haulers to the March meeting. The Recycling Committee requested to be notified of the outcome of this meeting. Minutes will be provided.

Next meeting scheduled for Thursday, March 6, 2008 at the Selectmen's Office, Webster, NH.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30pm.
