The meeting began at 7:05 P.M. with Chairman Irwin opening the meeting. Tom Mullins wanted to discuss the PAYT costs. There was considerable discussion between Steve Clough, Tom Mullins and Barbara Corliss about what Jim O'Brien had meant when he attended the August meeting about cost impacts affecting Webster regarding pay as you throw. Tom's question was whether PAYT was requiring additional labor to implement the program. Steve answered the question about what Jim O'Brien had meant by explaining that he did not expect any lines to be over budget this year.

The budget question was raised and Steve briefly reviewed the current budget proposal for the next fiscal year. We would put it on the agenda to go over it in more detail for the next meeting.

Richard Houston updated that the PAYT program were having issues with the strength of the bags and that there were 2 stronger options that could have been chosen however, they would have added considerable cost to the price per bag.

The September 2, 2010, minutes were reviewed. Richard Kennedy made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Rich Houston. All were in favor.
