The meeting began at 7:07 P.M. with Chairman Irwin opening the meeting. The draft minutes for November 4, 2010 were reviewed and after minor modifications Richard Kennedy made a motion to approve and Bob Lapree seconded the motion. The PAYT program reflected plenty of bags being purchased and strength was determined to be an issue that could not be resolved until next round of bag purchases and the cost went up so much for each millimeter of strength that was added.

The budget was reviewed by Steve Clough again and Karen Irwin's main concern was the fact that the Selectman had under budgeted the labor by considerable dollars from the previous years expense and they had taken the reduction Steve had suggested for the disposal costs. It seemed to take the reduction in disposal costs and reduce labor was not a consistent methodology.

At the next meeting we needed to go over our ordinances and make changes to update them and include issues regarding reuse and recycling of materials brought to the landfill as well as security issues of the transfer station.
