The meeting began at 7:10 P.M. with Chairman Irwin opened the meeting. The December 4, 2011 meeting minutes were reviewed. Bob Lapree moved to accept the minutes seconded by Richard Stretch Kennedy. All were in favor and the minutes were approved. January 6, 2011 minutes were reviewed. Rich Houston moved to accept the minutes seconded by Richard Stretch Kennedy. All were in favor and the minutes were approved. Then the February 3, 2011 minutes were reviewed and a motion was made to approve as amended. Barbara Corliss made the motion seconded by Richard Stretch Kennedy. All were in favor and the minutes were approved.

Next on the agenda was the PAY update. Steve Clough stated that trash was down some but he expected recycling to be still within the 20-27% range. We then went into a detailed review of draft ordinances. An additional definition of re-use needed to be on the first page, deleted upon approval of the boards and contractors employed by the town on page 2, Public use of the facility on page 3 was to be rewritten, Section 6 disposal of materials was rewritten on page 4, oil was deleted from page 5, and moved a paragraph in section 9 regarding mercury ban to section 10. More work was to be done by Barbara Corliss and Karen Irwin on the draft to go back to the committee for the next meeting. There was not an update on the Budget and no other business was discussed by the committee.

Public Comment: John Little asked about the ability to drive through the town transfer station facility when it was open as he can access it from his property. We had discussed how to post the property when we discussed the public use of the facility paragraph in the ordinance. Because the road that goes through the property would not be a posted area, we believed he could continue to go through when the transfer station was open. Martin Bourque recommended two changes to the ordinance on page 3 regarding open trucks and the underlining of two words and wood treated in place of rot-resistant on page 4 under pressure-treated paragraph.

Barbara Corliss moved to adjourn seconded by Bob Lapree. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
