Rich Houston brought up the security issue that we are potentially having with the transfer station and whether it was a concern for the new town well also. Some sort of surveillance equipment is being reviewed as an option within the budget for purchase. Richard Kennedy would also get some price estimates on what his son in law uses.

Public Comments: Frank Davis stated that we need to be concerned about the cost avoided by disposal rather than the monetary value of the recyclable.
