Chairman Irwin opened the meeting at 6:47 p.m. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Ellen Kontino-Cilley and seconded by Barbara Corliss. All were in favor. Steve started to update the committee on the permit application and that it was taking longer than expected. It is a long and involved process with the State of New Hampshire to update our Solid waste plan. The 1989 operating permit has 24 conditions most of which are obsolete. The facility report was reviewed and Steve went over the last year bag revenue information. Of Hopkinton's trash 70% came in regular bags or 306,000 bags, 152,000 came in PAYT bags and the average house throws away 1.5 bags per week. The bag fund only has \$21,000 in it where last year it had \$95,000 we have had a large decrease in bag revenues. Steve also went over the 1.4 Dioxin report and testing and handed out some new information on that toxin. No concerns were brought forward from the public. The next meeting was to be July 12, 2012 in Webster at 6:30 p.m instead of July 5, 2012. A motion was made by Ellen Kontino-Cilley to adjourn seconded by Barbara Corliss. The meeting adjourned at 8:21 p.m.
