

**MINUTES FOR THE HOPKINTON VILLAGE PRECINCT 2010 ANNUAL
MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY MARCH 18, 2010, AT 7:30 PM AT THE
HOPKINTON TOWN HALL**

Disposition of Articles: Mr. O'Donnell presided

ARTICLE 1: Election of officers

Tom O'Donnell's name was placed in nomination for Village Moderator, and the nomination was properly seconded. There were no further nominations. A vote was called and Tom O'Donnell was elected Moderator by unanimous voice vote for the ensuing year.

Gary Rietveld's name was placed in nomination for Clerk and the nomination was properly seconded. There were no further nominations and Gary Rietveld was elected Clerk by unanimous voice vote for the ensuing year.

Kimberly Lajoie's name was placed in nomination for Commissioner, and the nomination was properly seconded. There were no further nominations and Kimberly Lajoie was elected Commissioner by unanimous voice vote for a three year term.

Tim White's name was placed in nomination for member of the Water Board and the nomination was properly seconded. There were no further nominations and Tim White was elected member of the Water Board by unanimous voice vote for a three year term.

ARTICLE 2: Reports

There were no significant issues raised and the Precinct Chairman and Water Board indicated normal operation of business.

ARTICLE 3: Water Board Appropriations

It was moved and properly seconded to raise and appropriate the sum of \$ 62,730 for the general expenses and debt services of the Water Board, including:

Water service and administration	\$50,020
Principal payments on bonds and notes	\$10,210
Interest on Precinct Debt incurred for Water Dept.	\$2,500

No funds from the General Fund are included. All the money will be provided by the Water Board.

The Article for the Water Board appropriations was passed by unanimous voice vote.

Article 4: Village Precinct appropriations

It was moved and properly seconded to raise and appropriate the sum of \$23,372 for the general expenses of the Precinct, of which \$8,450 will be funded by available fund balance and \$14,922 will be raised by Precinct taxes.

The Article for Precinct appropriations was passed by unanimous voice vote.

ARTICLE 5: Any other business that may legally come before the Meeting;

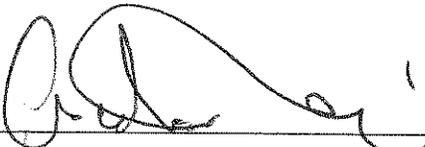
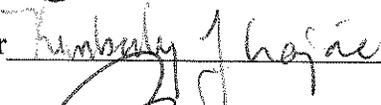
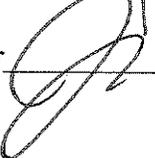
Resident Peter Dwyer was recognized by the Chairman. Mr. Dwyer noted that the Town at its annual meeting voted to dispose of the Horseshoe Tavern located on Main Street in the Village of Hopkinton. Noting its architectural and historical distinction, Mr. Dwyer asked if the Precinct would contact the Town Selectmen and inform them that there is interest among citizens of the town to preserve the tavern. The Chairman indicated that this interest would be communicated to the Selectmen for their consideration.
