(rain date April 27; decide by 8:30 if we need to postpone) Went over check list of final assignments - potting pansies, map routes, plans for notifying Lion's Club members who will pick up the full bags and deliver to the Transfer Station, Thank-you sign for contributors/helpers (Ginni will bring whiteboard for that) Sara will check with HYSA about the pinnies.

Sally and the Webster Conservation Commission have quite a few people signed up for the Webster project.
- Sally reported on Refuse Disposal Committee meeting - a joint meeting of the Selectboards will be held on May 20 at the Hopkinton town hall to discuss the proposed changes to the Trash Ordinance. Sally explained that the old DES permit is not sufficient even for current usage so needed to be updated.
- Hydration Stations - schools moving ahead so we don't need to work there anymore. Ginni plans to talk to *Elkay* rep about pricing for an outdoor station at Riverway Park.
- Discussed membership. Rosalie and Anne will continue. The town has sent out notice for new members needed.
