

**ROAD COMMITTEE MINUTES**  
**NOVEMBER 13, 2012**  
**APPROVED JANUARY 29, 2013**

Meeting was called to order at 7:01PM. Those attending were: John Chandler, Scott Coen, Lester Cressy, Kent Symonds, David White, Supt. Of Public Works John Thayer, and Selectman Bryan Pellerin.

I. Minutes of the September 11, 2012 meeting were approved as written.

II. We reviewed two applications to the Planning Board.

A. #2012-9 Two lot subdivision for John and Pamela Blackford. We decided this would have no impact on any town road, as access would be from Currier RD, a state road.

B. #2012-10 Site plan review to construct a 6000 S.F. addition to existing building of Prototek Sheet metal Fabrication at 244 Burnham Intervale RD. As this addition would only be used for warehousing and storage, we did not have any objection.

III. John Thayer updated the committee on the New Highway Garage. Final figures are not complete, but he is sure the total cost will be under the 1.3 million being asked for. No settlement with the Insurance as of this date. We discussed advantages and disadvantages of different heating systems and fuels.

IV. A. Pine ST pipe project: One section of pipe is collapsed, which will have to be excavated and replaced before slip-lining can proceed. This will be done tomorrow, November 14, and hopefully the slip-lining can start the next day.

B.RSMS: John has started feeding data into the system, he feels this is going to be a valuable system for planning and budgeting.

C. John reported the new 10-wheeler has been delivered, and the 6-wheeler should be ready by next week.

V. Change of meeting night: After a brief discussion we decided to change our meeting night to the last Tuesday of each month. This will give us time to review any applications to the Planning Board if necessary. Our next meeting will be January 29, 2013. Location to be determined.
