Board of Selectmen Nonpublic Session I Meeting Minutes January 4, 2010

Vice Chair Scott Flood called this Nonpublic Session to order at 5:31 p.m. on Monday, January 4, 2010, in the Town Administrator's office at the Town Hall. Those persons present were as follows:

Members Present: Scott Flood, Jim O'Brien, Chris Lawless and George Langwasser.

Staff Present: Steve Clough (Asst. Superintendent of Public Works – Waste) and Neal Cass (Town Administrator).

Mr. Clough stated that there is a tight time-frame to arrange where our trash will go if we leave the Concord Cooperative on January 31, 2010, but there are options. He explained that the Mount Carberry landfill in Berlin, NH is being under-utilized and is accepting, and even asking for additional trash. They are willing to sign a 6-year contract with an option to renew for another 6 years. This site is licensed for the next 50 years. Shipping can be negotiated with a possibility of contracting with a hauler at an even lower landfill tonnage price than being offered by the landfill. Mr. Clough will put the proposals in writing and provide the information to the selectmen.

Mr. Clough reiterated that it is a myth that there are not places to take trash.

There being no further business, Selectman O'Brien moved that the Board exit nonpublic session, and Selectman Lawless seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Vice Chair Flood called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Vice Chair declared the nonpublic session concluded at 5:55 p.m.

Selectman O'Brien moved that the minutes of the just concluded nonpublic session be sealed for a period of one year. Selectman Langwasser seconded the motion. Vice Chair Flood called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Vice Chair declared the motion carried.
