## **Board of Selectmen Nonpublic Meeting Minutes – Session I May 10, 2010**

Chair of the Board of Selectmen Jim O'Brien called this Nonpublic Session to order at 6:11 p.m. on Monday, May 10, 2010, in the Meeting Room at the Town Hall. Those persons present were as follows:

**Members Present:** Jim O'Brien, Tom Congoran, George Langwasser, Chris Lawless, and Bryan Pellerin.

**Staff Present:** Sue Strickford (Town Clerk/Tax Collector), Neal Cass (Town Administrator).

Mrs. Strickford reviewed the list of tax lien properties with the Board. She explained the process and that those that have been lien for two years and a day can be deeded. She explained that there are presently agreements in place with some of the owners.

After discussion, the Board decided:

1. If there presently is an agreement in place we will continue with the agreement.
  2. The interest will be abated on those properties that have agreements in place.
  3. The Town will pursue deeding the properties where the owner is not working with the Town.
- Mrs. Strickford said that there could be 10 properties that should be deeded.

There being no further business, Selectman Lawless moved that the Board exit nonpublic session, and Selectman Congoran seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (5-0) and the Chair declared the nonpublic session concluded at 6:48 p.m.

Selectman Congoran moved that the minutes of the just concluded nonpublic session be sealed for a period of 3 years. Selectman Pellerin seconded the motion. Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (5-0) and the Chair declared the motion carried.
