Board of Selectmen Nonpublic Meeting Minutes Session I August 1, 2011

Chair of the Board of Selectmen Jim O'Brien called this Nonpublic Session to order at 8:07 p.m. on Monday, August 1, 2011, in the large meeting room at the Town Hall. Those persons present were as follows:

Members Present: Jim O'Brien, George Langwasser, Bryan Pellerin and Denis Goddard.

Staff Present: Neal Cass (Town Administrator).

The Town Administrator reviewed with the Board the letter from E. Molly Stark of the Waste Water Division at DES concerning the lead and arsenic found in the wells of several homes on the outskirts of the landfill area. DES has determined that both the lead and arsenic are naturally occurring and they do not believe that their presence has been caused by the landfill. The Town does not need to take any further action at this time.

There being no further business, Selectman Langwasser moved that the Board exit nonpublic session, and Selectman Goddard seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Chair declared the nonpublic session concluded at 8:15 p.m.

Selectman Langwasser moved that the minutes of the just concluded nonpublic session be sealed for a period of 1 year. Selectman Pellerin seconded the motion. Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Chair declared the motion carried.
