Board of Selectmen Nonpublic Meeting Minutes – Session I November 7, 2011

Chair of the Board of Selectmen Jim O'Brien called this Nonpublic Session to order at 5:42 p.m. on Monday, November 7, 2011, in the Town Administrator's office at the Town Hall. Those persons present were as follows:

Members Present: Jim O'Brien, George Langwasser, Tom Congoran and Bryan Pellerin.

Staff Present: Neal Cass (Town Administrator)

Others Present: Gary Rondeau

Those gathered reviewed the recent letter from DES concerning the lead found in Mr. Rondeau's water. Mr. O'Brien stated that the DES letter is clearly saying that the Town is not causing the problem with the well. Mr. Rondeau said that the Town does not owe him anything, but that he is looking for a solution. The Board suggested that Mr. Rondeau do further testing including a source test. The Board would be open to further discussions including the possibility of connecting to the community well once the testing is complete and Mr. Rondeau has looked at his options.

There being no further business, Selectman Congoran moved that the Board exit nonpublic session and Selectman Langwasser seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Chair declared the nonpublic session concluded at 5:57 p.m.

Selectman Congoran moved that the minutes of the just concluded nonpublic session be sealed for a period of one year. Selectman Langwasser seconded the motion. Chair O'Brien called for the vote. All members present voted in favor (4-0) and the Chair declared the motion carried.
