Draft Minutes of meeting October 19,2009

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Janet Krzyzaniak.

Approval of Minutes: Don Lane made a motion to approve the minutes and Joanne seconded it. The vote was in the affirmative.

Business: Merle brought up the grate at the front door. In bad weather, people with walkers and canes should come in downstairs. Don said people should drive around, then let handicapped people out downstairs and take the elevator up.

For the committee to be called a council it must be approved by the selectmen, and George will bring this to a meeting. Don made a motion and Lillian seconded it. The vote was in the affirmative .

New Business: New Programs:
