I. Call to order; The meeting was called to order at 1:30 pm by Joanne Woodward.

II. Review and Approval of Minutes of Meeting February 27, 2012.

The members reviewed the minutes of this meeting, and no corrections were made. A motion was made and seconded that the minutes be approved as is, and were approved by a unanimous vote of all members present.

III. Old Business:

- 1) Repairs to the front porch wind screen are still in progress.
- 2) Jessica reported that STAPLES has a clip on type name tag with replacement insert cards at a cost of 40 for \$60. They can be ordered complete or printed separately. Replacement cards are also available. Jessica will order some samples.
- 3) Janet is working on the flagpole replacement to be completed this spring.
- 4) Jessica provided a catalog (Pichies in Belmont) covering embroidered Slusser jackets and vests. No shipping costs or setup fees. She plans to order some so we can determine the quality of the product and if they would be suitable for our use,
- 5) Cleaning out and proper storage of decorating material will be delayed until a spring cleaning of the barn. At that time heavy duty storage units should be considered for seasonal decorations. Lillian Landry requested that the area in the barn floor, with plywood provided by seniors, be left open from June to September to store flea market items for the fall sale.
- 6) Further discussion concerning the selectmen's decision to open the senior center for Recreation Department children's programs was tabled by the chairwoman, Joanne, until a meeting with the selectmen March 26, 2012.

IV. New Business:

Program Discussion:

Tom Walton's new fitness test program was successfully initiated on March 13th with most of Gloria Symonds exercise class participating. It is expected to repeat the tests in two months to check the groups progress..

VI. Citizen's Forum:

- 2) There was further interest from visitors in discussing the use of the Senior Center for children's programs. As previously noted in these minutes further discussion had been tabled until the selectmen's meeting.
