1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Suzi is out of town and unable to attend this month's meeting.
3. Mail and bills were reviewed.
4. Water System Operators (WSO) has installed the Data Loggers and Chronometer. Andrew will receive training from WSO and train Rich and Steve.
5. There was an issue with the caustic injection system, there was a hose loose but it has now been fixed.
6. The board agreed that a caustic level alarm should be considered for the future. It would require an internet connection in order to alert the board. This will be revisited in the future.
7. It was agreed that the current list of improvements should be reviewed to delineate "wants" from "needs" in order to prioritize spending.
8. D&K has almost completed their feasibility study of the planned system upgrades. The current tank is not large enough. They are in the process of researching the regulations, should be complete by 6/4/13
9. Leak detection has been completed – no significant leaks were found.
