

Monthly Hopkinton Precinct Water Board Meeting Minutes

Date: September 18, 2013
Time: 7:00 p.m.
Location: Town Hall
Attendees: A. Ashton; S. Lajoie, R. Armstrong;
No Present: S. Calley

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Mail and bills were reviewed.
3. D&K was present to discuss their report regarding water storage options.
4. Relocation of controls is not included in their proposal.
5. The current plan would leave the existing tank where it is and add a 30k gallon storage tank at the well site.
6. A booster pump somewhere in the system would require a holding tank of somewhere between 300 and 2,000 gallons at the booster pump location.
7. The board advises planning any pipe replacement to coincide with planned road repairs/resurfacing to avoid the cost of patching pavement.
8. Options for funding sources was briefly discussed including a Bond Bank, a State Loan Program, and a Federal Rural Development Grant. The Rural Development Grant would include income restrictions and other additional requirements.
9. D&K will submit their plan to the State for initial review and comments.
10. A budget estimate for design costs would be in the neighborhood of 10% - 20% of the total project cost
11. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm.
