

Monthly Hopkinton Precinct Water Board Meeting Minutes

Date: October 21, 2013
Time: 7:00 p.m.
Location: Town Hall
Attendees: A. Ashton; S. Lajoie, R. Armstrong, S. Calley

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Mail and bills were reviewed.
3. Accounts are mostly up to date. Suzi will call the few delinquent customers.
4. Suzi will contact the bank to investigate the system upgrade finance options. She will talk with them about the possibility of a loan of \$250k with a 20 year term.
5. There was trace coliform detected in one of the most recent water samples so a re-sample was collected. Second sampling included one sample with trace coliform as well. A notice will be issued with the next bill and Water System Operators will treat the water.
6. The NHDES sent a letter dated 10/7 that confirmed that the system's 3 year water conservation compliance has been completed.
7. The third quarter water use numbers have been submitted and accepted on-line by the State.
8. Powers Inc. will service the emergency generator on November 6th.
9. The beaver dam has been removed and is not being rebuilt.
10. The board discussed the need for a "no trespassing" sign at the well site. Andrew has noticed a few people walking up the drive to the well – probably because the new Hopkinton Greenway map shows the conservation land behind the well. It was decided that Andrew would continue to observe the drive and if the traffic continued we would put a sign inside the gate.
11. The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 pm.
