CONTOOCCOOK VILLAGE PRECINCT COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES JUNE 5, 2018 – 6:00 PM SLUSSER CENTER

I. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Chapin called this regular meeting of the Contoocook Village Precinct Commissioners to order at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, at the Slusser Center.

II. OPERATIONS

- a. Kent noted that the operations are going well at about 135k gallons per day average.
- b. Andrew and Lori Jennison requested ability to fill a new pool on their property. Approximately 25k gallons of water needed. Cost of \$112.50 charged.
- c. Consumer Confidence Report due in June. WSO will need to work with Kent on this.

III. POOL FILLING

- a. Discussion ensued regarding pool filling and creating guidelines for this type of service. Commissioners agreed this service would be available for precinct customers only.
- b. Would be on a case-by-case basis.
- c. Maximum of one pool fill for the system per day.
- d. Will be first come, first served basis.
- e. Precinct reserves the right to say no due to various conditions, etc.
- f. Absolutely no pool filling during water bans.
- g. Charges to be set at \$250 for initial 10k gallons, \$50 per 5k gallons thereafter.
- h. Commissioner Boudette made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Yestramski, to set the guidelines and charges for pool filling as stated.
- i. VOTE: Boudette, Yestramski and Chapin voting in favor of the motion; no votes against
- j. MOTION APPROVED 3-0

IV. ADJOURNMENT

- a. Commissioner Yestramski made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Boudette, to adjourn the meeting.
- b. VOTE: Yestramski, Boudette and Chapin voting in favor of the motion; no votes against
- c. MOTION APPROVED 3-0; meeting adjourned at 7:00pm
