

TOWN OF HOPKINTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE

USE OF TOWN PROPERTY

POLICY NO. 7

It is the purpose of this statement to provide directions and guidelines for groups wishing to use Town property. The feeling of the Board of Selectmen is that Town owned property should be available for use by Town residents and groups whenever possible. Conflict and overlapping activities will certainly occur and the Board of Selectmen will resolve those questions. While it is not possible to list or anticipate all the types of groups or organizations that may want to use Town facilities it is hoped that broad parameters can be used and that those uses which are not readily apparent will be referred to the Board of Selectmen for determination.

Civic groups or organizations

Charitable organizations

Business organizations located in Hopkinton holding outings, etc. for the benefit of their employees

Events sponsored by civic or charitable groups whose proceeds go to benefit the community

In addition to the above criteria, the activities must comply with town ordinances and policies relative to such areas as fire protection, police coverage, noise, traffic, insurance, etc.

A fee will be assessed for any activity which requires admission charges or sells merchandise. The amount will be determined by the Selectmen at the time of application. The fee will be appropriate to the level of activity expected.
