Meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by James Newsom

1. Ron Klemarczyk led a tour of the Tyler Landing property. Ron pointed out that the soils in the field are hydraulic, and an access road and parking area would require hardening. Noted the black plastic ground cover in the two refugee gardens. Looked at the potential boat put-in. Due to the high water level in the river, the ravine next to the potential boat put-in is flooded and a trail crossing would require a long bridge. Looked at the remains of an old camp foundation and nearby associated materials. Walked north along the river following an old road location and then followed a potential trail route along the perimeter of the property back to the field.
