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CONTOOCOOK VILLAGE PRECINCT COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES JANUARY 8, 2019 – 6:00 PM SLUSSER CENTER

I. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Chapin called this regular meeting of the Contoocook Village Precinct Commissioners to order at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 8, 2019, at the Slusser Center.

II. FINANCIAL REPORT

- a. The board reviewed the Financial Report as presented by Kathy Donohoe.
- b. Commissioner Boudette made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Chapin, to approve the financial report.

- b. Discussion ensued regarding a bad valve that was located on Woodwells Garrison that has been fixed.
- c. A new computer will be set up at the plant with the operating program. This will be taken from last year's budget.
- d. Discussion ensued regarding meter reading. Prescott will come out and ride with Kent and 25-30 meters were not read.
- e. Discussion ensued regarding bacteria testing and inspections, all came back good.
- f. Tom will perform a generator run-through.
- g. A bad valve was found at the top of Cedar Street and Maple Street. Discussion ensued on how the work to repair the valve will be performed.
- h. Discussion ensued regarding the drainage line at the Kimball Project. Will reach out to Mike Metcalf to discuss this.

V. OTHER

a. Annual Meeting date is set for March 21, venue to be determined.
