- e. Meter reading took place and bills have been sent out.
- f. Cedar Street is in the planning stages of being rebuilt. Discussion ensued regarding the Precinct infrastructure and what should be replaced during this project.

- a. Discussion ensued regarding the engineering and the progress with the firm.
- b. Received a communication from DES regarding a status update. The Precinct is currently waiting for the media replacement to take place and work with the engineering firm for the next step on further testing.
