- 1) Acceptance of November 21, 2019 minutes
- 2) Reported: new name (Hopkinton Waste Reduction Committee) and revised mission statement accepted by Select Board
- 3) School Task Force News:
 - *PTA gave \$3000 to Maple Street School to develop a scrap composting system. Amy Roth, lead person
 - *Discussion of work with Contoocook Creamery to deliver milk in bulk to avoid single use containers. Researching comparative cost and type of cups/glasses to use
 - *Discussion of reusable silverware vs plastic. Steve Chamberlain to ask Neal about purchasing reusable from the Recycling Revolving Fund. Ginnie to ask Tracy (food service) if the "once upon a time" reusable silverware is stored somewhere.
 - *Discussion about what really happens to mixed paper—recycled or disposed of by Waste Management. No conclusion. Considering "office" paper only vs. "mixed" for \$85/ton revenue
- 4) Conference call with Jolene
 - *Amount of time employees spend sorting recyclables—1-2 hr .daily
 - *Mixed paper overview: costs \$100/ton to recycle. Now going into hopper at \$69/ton to dispose of Select Board asked HWRC for suggestions
 - *Where does trash go? Waste Management owns our trash and hauls to Rochester
 - *Recycle for revenue? Last year all turned revenue except mixed paper and #5 plastic
 - *Out-of-towners dropping off trash—not an issue
 - *How can we help you? Clear, precise signage and outreach due to being understaffed, Ginnie and Rosalie volunteered to go on Saturday as HWRC volunteers

 - *brief discussion of plastic bag ban passed by the House
- 6) Library program
 - *Checking with Donna as to date/time
