Old Business

 <u>HSAC Spring Event</u> – The name for our spring event will be "Arranging Final Arrangements." It will take place Wednesday afternoon, April 18, from 1:00 – 3:00 PM at the Slusser Center. The purpose of the event is to inform community members about what to expect when making funeral/memorial arrangements: options, costs, legal aspects, how to create a service, etc.

Rev. Terry Odell, an interfaith minister from Penacook who officiates at celebrations of life, will be one of the presenters. She was present at our meeting to get a sense of what the committee is looking for and to offer input of her own. Michael Horne, the Director of the NH State Veterans Cemetery in Boscawen, will also be a presenter, and we will invite one of the Hopkinton Cemetery Trustees to present as well. Sue Yonkers, owner of Polkadots, has offered to do a T-shirt design competition with kids at cost of the T-shirts in support of a charitable program in Hopkinton. Marilyn selected the Got Lunch program. Kids will design T-shirts with whatever design they choose (they won't be Got Lunch T-shirts), and proceeds will support the Got Lunch program.

Got Lunch is serving 20 children. There is a pick-up once a month on Friday night at St. Andrew's Church that includes milk vouchers and egg vouchers from Colonial. They will send out boxes before the February vacation.
