- ➤ 15 attended the program before the Senior Luncheon. The luncheon was a success thanks to Marcia and the HSAC for providing food and serving.
- ➤ Although it was a smaller group, the Good Grief program went well.
- Shared harvest is receiving food donations from the Lions Club grow boxes and community garden, Work Song Farm, and from individuals.
- Alicia is working on lists for Christmas.
- Appreciation dinner has been advertised for Food Pantry workers. 40 people are expected.
- Alicia hosted an ice cream social at the Park Avenue apartments. 18 attended. It was very much appreciated. The Committee discussed supporting Alicia with programs and social gatherings at Park Avenue.
- ➤ Welfare assistance for the month of July included: Food \$598.06; rent \$2,700; and electric \$500.
