March 12, 2016

Article 3: To bond \$2,200,000 for road, bridge, and culvert rehabilitation.
Yes- 467-93.0% No- 35-7.0% Needed 66.7% **APPROVED**

Article 4: To bond \$3,426,225 for a track and synthetic turf field.
Yes – 65 – 12.5% No- 87.5% Needed 66.7% **FAILED**

Article 5: Operating budget of \$ 6,416,591.
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 6: Motor Vehicle Fee for road improvements.
Yes – 103 – 38.4% No- - 165 – 61.6% **FAILED**

Article 7: Establish a Road/Bridge Capital Reserve Fund and put \$250,000 in it.
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 8: Raise \$329,000 for existing Capital Reserve Funds
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 9: Raise \$32,500 for existing Expendable Trust Funds
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 10: Authorization for Select Board to negotiate for solar panels on Fire Station and Highway Garage.
APPROVED with just the required 2/3 vote

Article 11: Authorization to expend from Pay-by-Bag Special Revenue Fund
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 12: Rescind the Pay-by-Bag program
Yes- 161 No – 199 **FAILED** – (Pay-by-Bag remains)

Article 13: Set Pay-by-Bag price at \$0.75 and \$1.25
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 14: Authorization to expend from Senior Center Special Revenue Fund
APPROVED on voice vote

Article 15: Petition to “Get Big Money of Politics:
APPROVED on voice vote – gives a sense of the meeting
