#### OLD BUSINESS

#### NEW BUSINESS

1. The Center will be closed tomorrow, Feb. 28, because of an upcoming storm. The School is on vacation so they won't be making that call. Paula called all the program leaders to let them know the building is cancelled and to contact their participants.
2. Carole made a motion to elect Elaine Millerick as the chair of the Senior Rec Committee. Marilyn seconded the motion. All were in favor.
3. Jon made a motion to elect Bob Wardell as the vice chair of the Senior Rec Committee. Gloria seconded and all were in favor.
4. We had a discussion about the large number of participants coming to Yoga. We discussed options to move it upstairs or outside (in warm weather), limit attendance, have a sign up sheet and manage each class and charge for the class. It was decided that Paula would work with Mary, the Yoga instructor, about moving the class or maybe splitting it to an intermediate and beginner class.
5. This led to a discussion about potentially paying program leaders at the Slusser Center. After discussion, all seemed in favor of keeping it in accordance to the current policy to not pay senior program leaders. Elaine made a motion to continue with the policy of not charging for senior programs and to request donations. Bob seconded it and voted in favor. This means that the instructors are still volunteers and would not be paid for their time. We would however, put out more donation boxes and Paula will make signs requesting a \$1 per class/game.

Motion to end the meeting was made by Carole and was seconded by Betsey.
