 - Need a few documents notarized.
 - Need proof of the insurance that the water board/precinct carries.
 - May need some additional financial documents, reporting.
 - Need co-signing of authority to borrow authorization docs.
 - Need to update and resubmit many of the initial documents.
 - May need to hold a short meeting in early March for signatures when I have more time to pull all of this together, ideally when Suzi is back in town.
