 - A/R and A/P, review, and signatures.
 - Additional invoices from WSO+ for chlorine monitoring, repairs (Old Putney, Lakehouse connections), new user install (Briar Hill).
 - Budget discussion.

- Sulfur and Chlorine Issues
 - Thanks, Sandy, this one will go down in the history books.
 - Irrigation company created the issue when inspecting a property in the system, which ended up costing the precinct an additional \$2500.
 - Additional testing required post-chlorination; discussion with WSO+.
 - Clean the chlorine dispensing equipment ahead of next need.
- Low Pressure Reports
 - Main well pump breaker tripped, now have instructions on how to reset; reset process involves cabinet with high voltage; discuss precautions we should follow.
 - Julie H on South Rd reported low pressure before the pump breaker tripped, requested updated late last week.
- Lead and Copper Sampling
 - Every three years, happening now (Q4).
 - 10 sites in the district are being sampled.
 - We will need to provide a letter to all system users and an attestation to DES by March 30, 2022.
- Project Status
 - Basic electrical conduit has been run.
 - Review of updated schedule that Joe provided.
 - DES has been notified as to schedule change, may reach out to WSO directly.
- Thomas Morin Lot Lines Adjustment Discussion
 - Scott Clang at GSWRA was not able to locate any legal language for future water protection to add to the deed.
- Snow Plowing for Site
 - Contract awarded to New Yard for this winter.

- Testing: We have a chemical waiver, which should save us money twice per year, 3 years.
