- Finance Update
 - A/R and A/P, review, and signatures.
 - Other financial topics for review.
 - 70K Loan closed.
- Sulfur and Chlorine Issues
 - H2S gas in the water at three customers on Hopkinton Rd and three on South led to the decision to chlorinate.
 - Many complaints, new ones daily about the chlorination.
 - WSO+ has been monitoring and levels are safe, but difficult for customers to live with.
 - Limited improvement at customer sites on Hopkinton Rd, the question is when will the chlorine be effective. Internet searches would lead one to believe that we should have seen more improvement before now; so what's the next step.
 - How can we better engage with WSO+ and with customers if this is going to take some additional time to address?
 - How did this happen, and how do we keep it from happening again? Do we need to shock the backup well?
- Project Status
 - Site work should have been completed; not sure if the top of the hill will/should remain as it is currently.
 - Next step would be electrical, no timeframe yet.
- Thomas Morin Lot Lines Adjustment Discussion
 - No updates.
- 96 Old Putney Rd Water Disconnect
 - WSO+ to address the valve/mechanism failure
- Briar Hill Road New Construction
 - Connected to the water system.
 - Waiting for invoice from WSO+ so we can provide a complete invoice to Mark.
- Asset Management
 - Schedule training.
- Water Source Protection Grant
 - Initial application delivered by Nov 1 deadline.
 - Looking for feedback likely that would help us with next year's round.
 - Looking to fund a few cameras, door sensors, storage system, computer and Internet on site.
- Meter reading for December – Rick; Meter reading for January – Mike.
- Testing: No update on chemical waiver. No info yet on PFAs test status.
- WSO+ Contract – edit in process, copy for review around Thanksgiving.
