FOLLOW-UP TO EDC VISIONING SESSION

Ms. Lee reviewed the work that was done at the last meeting to refresh memories and bring all up to speed. There was discussion of what was being created and after discussion there was consensus that a tag line for the EDC on behalf of the Town was being created. Further discussion took place and the Committee decided to think about the discussion and come back for further discussion at the next meeting.

ECONOMIC STRATEGIC PLAN (attached to minutes)

Mr. Monahan reviewed the draft Economic Development Strategic Plan. Comments from the Committee included:

• Further details for the collaboration with Henniker include zoning ordinance reviews, infrastructure, and transportation elements.

- Mr. Whitley stressed that the EDC would like a road map as to how to get from where things are now to where the committee wants them to be. It was decided that there needs to be two documents, one with the general areas and then a document that included very specific tasks.
- Mr. Monahan will identify details for all short-term bullets.
- Ms. Wells noted that in the MTAG survey, recreation was strongly identified in connection to uses of Hart's Corner.
- There were several comments as to the importance of the Business Retention/Expansion/Recruitment program.
- Mr. Fredyma noted that the Hopkinton village area should be part of the short-term list and that the Exit 4 "gateway" should be part of the long-term list.
- Ms. Wells requested that the review of Contoocook village charette be done as there are things, although not easy, that can be done in the village.
- Mr. Whitley requested added detail and noted the need for a build-out analysis. He also highlighted the importance of the 79E and ERZ maps.

There was consensus that the plan needs refining. Mr. Monahan will do this and bring it back to the next meeting.

UPDATES

- Mr. Monahan will be calling potential members for the Exit 6 TIF Advisory Committee beginning in mid-January.
- The ERZ Workshop will take place on Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. via Zoom. CNHRPC has mailed postcards to all property owners. The link for the meeting is on the Town website.
- Mr. Cass reported that the Town has received the deeds and the plan for recording for the land swap with the State. The hope is that the closing will be in the very near future.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIC PLAN

The following is a summary of proposed economic development related efforts which can be undertaken by the Board of Selectmen, Planning Board and Economic Development Committee over the next few years. A key element of the proposed efforts is close coordination between Hopkinton's Boards and Committees as well as the Town of Henniker and regional economic development planning efforts such as future regional comprehensive economic strategy (CEDS) updates.

SHORT-TERM (THROUGH 2021)

- Promote mixed-use development opportunities in the Commerce and Community Overlay District (CCOD) in West Hopkinton along NH127 (Maple Street) to the north of the US202/NH9/NH127 intersection.
 - Coordinate with the Henniker Board of Selectmen/Planning Board/Economic Development
 Committee related to the future US202/NH9/NH127 project during the biennial update of State of New Hampshire Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan.
 - Consider potential projects funded under the Hart's Corner Tax Increment Finance (TIF) district to promote future development in the area.
 - Coordinate with the Henniker Board of Selectmen/Planning Board/Economic Development
 Committee related to zoning changes and economic development plans in vicinity of intersection.
- Promote the availability and use of the Exit 6 and Contoocook Village Economic Revitalization Zones (ERZs) to property/business owners.
- Promote the availability and use Contoocook Community Revitalization Tax Relief Incentive (RSA 79-e).
- Review the recommendations included in 2000 Contoocook Village Charette. Consider updating select plans/recommendations within the Charette to promote future investment and mixed-use activities within the Village.
- Examine options to modify permitted uses and zone boundaries within the Burnham-Intervale M-1 zone.
- Consider the future adoption of the Commercial and Industrial Construction Exemption (NH RSA 72: 80-83) within select M-1 zone areas.
- Undertake continued Economic Development Committee Activities
 - Continually update the EDC Website.
 - Promote available commercial sites through the NH Division of Economic Development selectnh.com commercial site listing.
 - Develop a Business Retention/Expansion/Recruitment Program.
 - Investigate USDA/CDBG/EDA funding options for water infrastructure study/improvements, potentially in coordination with Exit 6 or Harts Corner TIF funding.

LONG-TERM (2022+)

- Undertake a Water/Sewer Improvements Feasibility Analysis, address potential Improvements and/or Expansion.
- Investigate applying for CNHRPC Regional Brownfields Assessment Program funding to assess the former Bio-Energy site.
