REPORT FROM LIBRARY DIRECTOR

February 20, 2024

Library Staff: We are in the process of hiring a new circulation assistant. I attended a workshop on Artificial Intelligence and a webinar about spring book releases. A volunteer who is a nurse came to our staff meeting on Friday, 2/16, to give staff a refresher on using the AED machine. Special thanks to Chief Yale for letting us borrow the CPR dummies and teaching AED machine. Goal Two 1c.

Finance: The town audit is this week and I have provided the backup documents (bank statements, treasurer's reports, minutes etc.) for the library. We are operating without an approved budget until Town Meeting on Thursday, March 21st. Goal One 2bandc and Goal Two 1b.

Library Services: Circulation was up 15% in January, as were library visits. We added 26 new card holders. Goal One 1a 4a, Goal Two 2a-e.
