CALL TO ORDER

Janet Krzyzaniak called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m., at the Town Hall.

APPROVAL OF JUNE 7, 2017, PUBLIC HEARING DRAFT MINUTES

Ken Traum moved to approve the June 7, 2017, Public Hearing Draft Minutes, as amended by Matt Cairns and Mark Zankel. Amy Bogart seconded the motion. Discussion followed, there were no further changes. A vote was taken and all approved.

APPROVAL OF JULY 12, 2017, MINUTES

FINANCIALS

SELECT BOARD

SCHOOL BOARD

Matt Cairns suggested that ways should be looked for through Economic Development to grow or increase revenues, so that cuts aren't needed in the budget every year.
