# **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

The library is right on target for our budget- 25% of the budget remains for the year. There was a discrepancy on the expenditure report regarding copier supplies. Donna will work with the town to fix this issue.

Staffing was discussed including finding someone to help on the reference desk for the weekends. Circulation went up 3% from last year. Ebooks are up quite a bit at 35%. The community room usage at the library has gone up as well, and patrons are appreciative that they can use the rooms once again. Computer use is up as well, and more computers have had to be turned on at times. There have been wonderful programs this last month, and they have been well attended. There will be a presentation on trash given by the Hopkinton Waste Committee on 10/20/22.

Amy has brought up the possibility of installing solar panels on the library. Amy will research how much this would cost and where they could be installed.

Jason presented a picture of how the patio could look that would be adjacent to the community room. We could potentially have a local landscaper install the patio.

The trustees reviewed a new policy grid and discussed which policies should be added and/or reviewed.
