Suzi Calley will contact Primex regarding insurance on the clock.

Commissioner Wieland will contact the Hopkinton Historical Society regarding their interest in the HVP Fire Station and Fire King Pumper Truck housed inside. To generate interest, discussion was had to decorate the HVP Fire Station for the upcoming Memorial Day Parade with Bunting and open the front doors for townspeople to view the Fire King Pumper Truck. Commissioner Casolaro would take charge and monitor.

Commissioner Casolaro agreed to monitor the HVP Street Lights.

Commissioner Lipoma agreed to review the HVP Zoning Board and Planning Board Ordinances in consultation with the NH Municipal Association.

Commissioners Wieland and Casolaro along with Linda Dunning are conferring on a road sign for the HVP.


With no other business at hand, Commissioner Wieland adjourned the HVP Meeting at 8:10 pm.
