

MINUTES FOR THE HOPKINTON VILLAGE PRECINCT MEETING

August 15, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chair Wieland, who also acted as clerk.

Minutes for the July 18, 2019, meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote.

Primex (insurance)	\$1362.78



A discussion was held about the water analysis done by the School District at Harold Martin School to bring Com. Casolaro up to date. The analysis showed a lead amount higher than allowed at the test site "before "meter", but not at any other test site within the school. The Water Commissioners responded by letter to the School District re lead amount standards, testing results and, if necessary, the District's responsibility for remediation.

A discussion also addressed the fundraising to pay for the refurbishment of the HVP clock works (\$5500). Com. Lipoma will draft a request for donations to be sent to all residents of the Town of Hopkinton, as the presence of the clock is of value to the entire town.

Finally, commissioners discussed the HVP Fire House and the interest of the Hopkinton Historical Society. Com. Casolaro ran a title search and found mention of the building. He will review a recently found book of precinct minutes re this issue.

The meeting ended at 8 pm.
